



PROJECT NDYWCOD

India is a unique country, with people of diverse religions, cultures, languages and heritage living together as one nation. Indian cinema, apart from being the chief source of entertainment, place it's role as a great unifier of people too. Spreading the wings of liberation, our films went through a series of major transformations, encompassing varied hues of human emotions while blending them with vibrance and magic of the big screen.

Though the largest film producing nation in the world, India lags behind the global standards in terms of quality of distribution and exhibition of films, ranking far behind in the list of the best movie making industries in the world. The lag is mainly due to the fragmentation of the industry on the basis of language and geographical barriers within the country. The 10 Billion USD 'Project Indywood' conceptualized by the globally acclaimed filmmaker Sohan Roy , envisages sweeping and revolutionary changes in the production, screening and marketing strategies as well as business model of the Indian cinema. The successful completion of this five year project is expected to elevate India to the pinnacle of global film industry.

The 10 Billion USD investment in India is channelled through a consortium of 2000 corporate firms and NRI investors in the form of 10,000 new 4K projection multiplex screens, 100,000 2K projection home cinemas, film studios, animation/ VFX studios and film schools conforming to international standards. Other features of the project include promoting the concept of film tourism by bringing in international film projects, industrial delegates and tourists to India, launching international co-production projects from India using Indian talents, formation of India based ' World Film Society' to operate as the integration hub of the world film industry and its associations, establishing world's largest film school, animation school and media school in India, establishing copyright protection and anti-piracy measures in India to protect film and music industries, to introduce the concept of CSR movies in India to support the debutante directors and producers and many more.

Another important mission of the project is to organize the first film carnival in India with film festival, film market, red carpets, awards, entertainments, theme parks, talent hunt, Excellence Awards, conferences, panel discussions, networking parties and investor meets. All Lights India International Film Festival, Indywood Film Market, Indywood Talent Hunt, Indywood Interactions etc are some of the major wings of Project Indywood.

'Project Indywood' aims to explore new avenues of market for Indian cinema. The promotion and sale of regional contents in international market, exchange of local technologies and man power, global networking of major production houses and collaborative ventures making use of local talents are some of the key highlights of the project.

'Project Indywood' is a launching pad for the Indian film industry to launch itself to the dizzy heights of global leadership. Join this incredible entertainment revolution - The Indywood Revolution- and Celebrate the Culture of India.

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
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International Competition for Feature Films



Shawkat Amin Korki Film Director, Iraq

Born in Iraqi Kurdistan in 1973, Shawkat Amin Korki and his family fled from military oppression in 1975, living in exile in Iran for 24 years. During his years in Iran and then when he returned to Iraqi Kurdistan, he began to work for the theatre, television and the cinema. His short films, made between 1997 and 2005, have been presented at several international festivals, winning awards. Korki wrote, directed and produced his first feature film in Iraqi Kurdistan, Crossing The Dust, in

2006. was shown at the International Film Festival of Rotterdam in 2007. The film went on to win many international prizes including the Best Director and NETPAK Award at Singapore International Film Festival. His second feature Kick Off (2009) won twelve international awards including the Busan International Film Festival New Currents Award and FIPRESCI Prize. His third feature, Memories on Stone (2014), has won fifteen awards internationally to date including in 2014 Best Film from the Arab World at the Abu Dhabi Film Festival and the coveted APSA UNESCO Award.He lives and works in Erbil, Iraqi Kurdistan.



Sonja Prosenc Writer/Director, Slovenia

After the university diploma Sonja attended Berlinale and Sarajevo Talents and was selected to TorinoFilmLab. Her acclaimed debut feature film The Tree was developed at EAVE and Baltic Event and premiered at Karlovy Vary IFF 2014. In its festival run the film received FIPRESCI Prize and other awards, and excellent reviews. It is the Slovenian OSCAR submission 2016. Her awarded short Morning was broadcasted in 31 countries. History of Love is her second feature film.



P Vasu Director

P. Vasu is an Indian director, writer and actor who works in Tamil, Kannada, Telugu and Malayalam films. In a career spanning three decades, Vasu has directed over 60 films. Vasu has won recognition for his work from the film fraternity and the state government. He won state awards for three years in a row from 1990, for Best Screenplay and Dialogues in Nadigan, in 1991 as Best Director in Chinna Thambi, and in 1992 for Best Screenplay and Story in Walter

Vetrivel. He was awarded the Filmfare award for Best Direction in the movie Aaptha Mithra. He was awarded the Kalaimaamani Award in 2004, with his father Shri M. Peethambaram who was an awardee for his contribution in the field of make-up.

Vasu is a member of the state award selection committee and jury member of the committee for tax-free movies.

Director, Producer, Line Producer, Cambodia

Kulikar is the Director of 'The Last Reel', a Khmer-language feature film due for release in 2014. She is also a Producer on the award-winning 'Ruin', which won the special Orizzonti prize at the Bienniale Venice Film Festival. She is also one of the most experienced Line Producers in Cambodia and worked on feature films 'Tomb Raider' and 'Wish You Were Here'. She has also worked on countless television documentaries for BBC, Discovery and other leading channels, plus several

globally important commercials. Kulikar can facilitate all filming permissions, all accommodation and transport requirements, temporary import/re-export of equipment and assist with the recruitment of local crew. Add to that her excellent contacts with leading politicians and filmmakers in the region and she can keep your production on course.

Pan Nalin Film Director, India

Pan Nalin' ANGRY INDIAN GODDESSES has been enjoying top critical and commercial success across the world. It is the first Indian film to win Audience Choice Award First RunnerUp at the Toronto International Film Festival 2015 and Prix du Public at the Rome Film Festival 2015; followed by many other awards. Pan Nalin came into global limelight with SAMSARA (Miramax/Disney) a massive commercial and critical success worldwide and won him some thirty plus international awards. Many critics and spectators considered SAMSARA a groundbreaking film. SAMSARA grossed US\$ 36 million. Till date, it remains the highest grossing Indian Independent film. Nalin's romantic epic VALLEY OF FLOWERS was pre-sold to nearly 35 countries and considered a major underground hit. It still continues to enjoy multiple-platform release with cult, critical and commercial success worldwide. As a writer, Nalin's latest tragicomedy screenplay SLIGHTLY SANE recently won the CJ Entertainment's Award for The Best International Project at Asia Film Market of Busan International Film Festival, South Korea. Nalin has also made several documentaries with BBC, Discovery, Canal Plus and other leading international networks. His multiple awards winning feature documentary AYURVEDA: ART OF BEING was theatrically released worldwide with major success. Nalin's latest feature documentary FAITH CONNECTIONS was an Official Selection at Toronto (2013), won the Audience Choice Award at IFFLA Los Angeles (2014) and it has been theatrically released worldwide. In 2006 Pan Nalin was awarded Spain's highly prestigious Vida Sana Award. Also in 2007, David Flint's Triangle Media Group UK, awarded Pan Nalin as one of the Top 50 Achievers in Global Mainstream Media in the field of Film, Theatre & Drama. Nalin also made it into The Better India's prestigious list of "25 NRI (Non-Resident Indians) Across The World Who Have Made India Proud."Presently Nalin is filming THE DISAPPEARANCE OF EVA HANSEN, a spiritual thriller set in the Himalayas. It's a first New Zealand – India coproduction starring David Wenham and Emmanuelle Beart.

Rajesh Touchriver Film Director . India

Rajesh Touchriver, an internationally acclaimed filmmaker, has by now directed films that have won 18 international awards, 3 national awards and several critical accolades. His recent film, 'Naa Bangaaru Talli(2013) that he scripted and directed, fetched what has been elusive for the Telugu film industry for more than 25 years – 3 National Awards from the Government of India. Besides, it won 8 International Awards and 8 Official selections in International Film Festivals. He has also



served on the jury of 62nd National Film Awards, Govt. of India, 2014. Rajesh pursued his Masters in Visual Language/ Scenography and Direction from the Wimbledon College of Art, London, UK. Life in London as a student marked the beginning of his career as a filmmaker. His controversial debut film, a British Film, 'In the Name of Buddha' (2002) was based on the ethnic crisis then raging in Sri Lanka. It was premiered at the Oslo International Film Festival and was noted for the sensitive treatment of a controversial theme through a heart-wrenching story. Besides being nominated for the Best Debut Director category at the Cannes Film Festival, in 2003, the film has well received in many international film festivals and has won 8 international awards. The film was, however, banned in India, Sri Lanka and China. His first brush with the film industry was in 1996 as a Production Designer for Telugu, Hindi and Hollywood films. By then, Rajesh had directed more than 30 plays in Malayalam, English, Telugu and Hindi. Following the success of 'In the Name of Buddha', Rajesh strode all genres of filmmaking with ease and has won critical acclaims, recognitions and awards. He directed the music video for 'Sunshowers' for the Oscar nominee M.I.A. 'Ente Malayalam', a music video to celebrate the 50th year of Kerala formation, captured noted Malayali achievers of Kerala in evocative frames. In addition to 7 feature films, Rajesh has by now directed about 35 short films and documentaries on issues ranging from human trafficking, HIV/AIDS and communal riots, supporting the media advocacy initiatives of the United Nations and NGOs, national and international. A film for the United Nations, 'One Life, No Price' for social sensitization against human trafficking was well received by civil society organizations internationally. Amitabh Bachchan, Preity Zinta and John Abraham appear in the film as spokespersons for the cause. Another success, 'Anamika, the Nameless' on a similar theme was adventurously shot in the red light areas of India in Mumbai, Kolkatta, Poona and Delhi. The film won the AC award under the 'Best Foreign Award - Documentary Short Film' category and the Best Documentary Film Award at the Hyderabad International Film Festival. The film has been included in the curriculum of National Police Academy and National Judicial Academy. 'The Sacred Face', a short film on child sexual abuse, sent the audience back home unsettled at its screening in Hyderabad and Canne's Film festival.

Simone Mariani Actor/Producer ,Italy

Born in Rome, Simone Mariani is a professional actor, producer and author, working professionally in Cinema, Television and Theater. Recently work as actor in a Hollywood production for the film "Inferno" directed by Ron Howard, starring Tom Hanks. He love to practice Sunmudo an ancient Zen martial art, practiced by Korean Zen monks. His short films have participated in numerous national and international festivals including the Festival film market in Clermont – Ferrand

(France). He is the author of short film "The Bicycle" (2005) which won numerous festivals in Italy and which focuses on exploring the integration of people and diversity on a thematic level. In 2006 he produced and acted in a short film "Iram la città dalle alte colonne", which is an interpretation of a text by Kahlil Gibran. This film won a Critics Award Akab film Festival in 2006. He is the author of "The Juggler" (2007), a tribute to street artists; this film was selected for a world tour by IFCT Festival 2007 in Miami (USA). In 2008 he debuted as a director with the short film "The Artist" where he also played the leading male part. He is the author, producer and performer of the short "The Father" (2011) on the subject of pedophilia. "A Journey on the Tabla" (2015) is his first documentary film. All his work has been selected in National and International film festivals. Currently, continues to carry out its activities as an actor, creating works, particularly focusing on the integration of peoples and diversity.

Wolman was born in Jerusalem, in what was then the British Mandate of Palestine. Dan Wolman's films have been presented at competitions at Cannes and Venice film festivals and many others winning awards and prizes the world over. His last film "Valley of Strength" which was released in 2011, was a big success in Israel and won prizes in Berlin, France, Rumania, India and China. Dan received a "Life time achievement award" at Ierusalem International film festival and "The Silver

Hugo" award at the Chicago International Film Festival for "Unique vision and innovative work". Wolman has been a judge in several international and Israeli film festivals.

AJITA SUCHITRA VEERA is an Indian Film Director-Producer-Writer-Illustrator, Photographer and Actor. She is one of the most significant modern Directors to emerge in the contemporary New Indian cinema from India. Ajita, studied Science, Theatre, Photography & Cinema at the prestigious National Film Institute India, (FTII) Pune India and worked as a freelance Director, till she founded IMAGINEM CINEMA Pvt Ltd in 2009 -a Motion Picture Company for Producing imaginative,

innovative and original cinema from India.

His first documentary "Surabhi" received National Award as Best Anthropological documentary. His first feature film later, "The rite .. a Passion" (Tiladaanam) has received worldwide

acclaim, He has served as a FIPRESCI jury member in the International Film Festivals of Sochi (Russia), and Pusan (South Korea), was one among the the Jury of Vladivostock International Film Festival and was also appointed as chairman IFFI - Goa 2008, National Awards Jury, 2004, for Best writing on Cinema, Eastern Section of films for National award in 2012, Critics Jury, Childrens' International Film Festival, Hyderabad in 1997 and Jury member for the AP State Nandi Awards panel.

Manju Borah Film Maker, India

Manju Borah is a multiple international and national award-winning Indian female film director and short story writer from Guwahati, Assam. Manju has served as Jury Member in Indian Panorama, IFFI, 10th MAMI International Film Festival , 3rd Eye 7th Asian Film Festival Mumbai and 55th National Film Awards(Feature Films). She has won 4 National award for Baibhab (1999), Aakashitorar Kothare (2003), Aai Kot Nai(2008) and Ko:Yad (2012). Her latest film Dau Huduni



Methai (Song of The Horned Owl) is an official selection at many national and international film festivals. The filmmaker has a series of Documentaries, Tele films and Tele serials to her credit.

She has served as Jury Member for Indian Panorama in the year 2007 and 2011, 55th National Film Awards for 2007, Chairperson of the Jury, North Zone & Jury Member of the Central Panel, National Film Awards, 2013, Jury at 10th MAMI International Film Festival 2008, 3rd Eye 7th Asian Film Festival Mumbai 2008 and Chairperson of the Jury, OSCAR Screening Committee 2012, Film Federation of India. She is a recipient of a Senior Fellowship from the Central Ministry of Culture for the years 2005 to 2007 on her work associated with Women folklore of Assam. She has been awarded the Women of Excellence Award by FICCI for her outstanding contribution to the field of Film & Entrepreneurship in the year 2009 and the Satyajit Ray Memorial Award given by the Asian Film Foundation for the year 2012 for working to spread film culture in India as a life time mission.

P. Sheshadri Film Maker, India

P. Sheshadri - A postgraduate in Kannada Literature and a diploma holder in journalism, after a short stint as Journalist, he entered Film land in 1990 as Screenplay and dialogue writer. In 1995 he became Independent Director of Television serials, Documentaries and Tele films. His maiden effort as Director of feature film MUNNUDI (A Preface) in the year 2000 has brought him great applause for his sensitive approach to cinema and was also hailed as a landmark film. He followed it up with



ATITHI (The Guest-2001), BERU (The Root-2004), THUTTURI (The Bugle-2005), VIMUKTHI (Liberation-2008), BETTADA JEEVA (Man of the Hills-2010), seventh film BHARATH STORES (2012), and eight film DECEMBER-1 (2013). All these EIGHT films received National Award. He is the first director to receive eight consecutive National Awards.

International Competition for Documentaries

Claudia Levin Film Director/Producer, Israel

Claudius Films, founded by Claudia Levin, is an independent production company committed to raising original and unheard voices through film, television, theater and new media. Claudius Films Ltd. has consistently taken on dark, controversial issues and used them to create vital, engaging films. Claudia Levin, the owner and founder of Claudius Films, is an award-winning creative producer with over 17 years experience in the industry. Her own life, which has taken her from



Argentina to Israel to New York and back again, has been instrumental in dictating her choice of production projects. The "outsider" status, common to so many immigrants, has given Levin the eye to identify, and then observe, stories emanating from some of the most marginalized elements in society. Whether it is the daily struggles of homeless women in south Tel Aviv (Bums, Go Home), the challenges faced by Palestinians in a village that is constantly harassed by the Israeli army (Bil'in, My Love), or the contradictions lived by transgender Filipinos who emigrated to Israel in order to care for elderly Orthodox Jewish men, each feature from Claudius Films uncovers an untold story that reveals broader truths about our society.
